

On September 28th, Success by 6 (SB6), Peel’s advisory group for the OEYCFC project, participated in a facilitated discussion to identify key principles that will inform OEYCFC planning in Peel. The group received a status update on the working group membership and project timelines and also approved the Terms of Reference, which were revised to better reflect SB6’s role as Peel’s integrated planning table for the early years.

Facilitated Discussion:

The Region of Peel facilitated an activity to develop Peel’s vision for planning OEYCFCs. Through this activity, the group identified key information that will be used to prioritize the project’s work activities. They included:

- Guiding principles to inform the planning process
- Existing strengths of the sector to build on
- Opportunities to improve services and programs under the early years transformation

Working Groups:

- The Region of Peel presented a list of members for each of the working groups. The Local Needs Assessment and Research working group started its work in September 2016. The Family Engagement and Program and Service Development groups will start to convene in October 2016. The remaining groups – Capital Planning, Performance Metrics, and Local Policy Planning – will convene in 2017.
- The initial plan will be submitted to the province in May 2017. It will include information on the OEYCFC programs and services, a summary of the local needs assessment, rationale for site distribution and locations, as well as a plan to ensure a smooth transition and effective family engagement.
- The initial plan will be presented to SB6 for endorsement in March 2017 and will be presented to council in April 2017. For more information, please see the OEYCFC Timeline – Phase I.

SB6 Terms of Reference:

The group approved the final version of the terms of reference. The latest version incorporated all of the suggestions made by the SB6 members at the August meeting.
